Will you help us keep dogs, cats and horses safe?

The RSPCA Felledge Animal Centre provides specialist treatment and rehabilitation to dogs, cats and horses who have suffered cruelty and neglect throughout the North East. We work to give unwanted and mistreated animals a second chance and find loving new homes for them.

Central to our rehabilitation and treatment programs working successfully is the environment here. Many of the animals brought into our care have never had the loving home environment, warm bed and fresh supply of food and water that pets need. Our cat pens, kennels and stables provide a safe haven in which these animals can flourish and learn to trust people.

Unlike other animal sponsorship schemes, safe haven sponsorship enables you to sponsor an average of four different animals every year (even more if it's a case of puppies or kittens!) that will have a temporary stay with us.

It costs £600,000 to run Felledge every year and we could not carry out our work without the generous support of the public. So whether you would like to sign up yourself, as a gift for a friend, on behalf of your business or in memory of a loved one lost, you will know your money is being put to good use.

Case Studies

Jade and her five, four week old kittens were abandoned on the doorstep of Felledge in a cardboard box, cold and scared. All were extremely underweight and several of them were suffering with eye infections. We provided a safe haven in which they could flourish. They all received specialist diet plans and veterinary treatment, along with much needed love and socialisation. They have since been matched with ideal owners.

Polly, a trotter cross, was taken into the care of our equine centre weighing only 265kg, which was half her recommended weight. She was put on a specialist diet and given daily weight checks. Slowly her confidence began to shine through, as she put on weight and began to trust the equine staff. Polly is still in our care and is currently being broken in by grooms, so that her new owner can enjoy riding her.

Tammy and her nine lurcher puppies were brought into our care by an RSPCA inspector who was extremely concerned about their poor living conditions and their weight. Tammy and her puppies thrived in our care and all achieved a healthy weight and were matched with loving new owners who have followed on with the training programs which our centre staff implemented.
