## **Privacy**

This privacy statement relates to the joint petition calling for an end to the keeping and trade of primates as pets.

The RSPCA is the data controller in respect of personal data collected from individuals signing this petition. This means that the RSPCA will hold and process all personal data supplied by signatories for the purposes of either:

- a. transferring it to the organisation/s which the individual has ticked the box/es stating they would like their details to be transferred to. Following that transfer, unless the individual has consented to their data being used for purposes by the RSPCA, any personal identifiers will be removed from that individual's personal data by the RSPCA. No individual will receive communications from the RSPCA unless they have consented to do so.
- analysing and using the data in an anonymised form to help achieve the campaign goals., however, you will not receive any RSPCA communications from completing the form or ticking the box above.

The RSPCA uses a third party, <u>Engaging Networks Ltd</u>, to host the petition page and data supplied by signatories is securely stored on Engaging Networks system.
