# 1. Overall Job Purpose

Establish and promote testing best practice and defect prevention throughout the Society adhering to the testing strategy.

Working in a variety of project teams ensure formal testing of systems, applications or hardware is undertaken and delivered to a high standard in accordance with agreed test strategies and test plans

# 3. Key Tasks/Job Description

# Leadership & Management

- Promote adoption of the overall Testing Strategy throughout the Society and demonstrate the value of this approach by ensuring consistent IT compliance.
- Manage and coordinate project testing activities as directed by project management or workstream leads.
- Lead the support and facilitation of business acceptance testing of IT solutions as required.
- Coach, train and mentor test analysts and business testers in the use of test tools the test strategy.

### **Test Authority**

 Approve the migration of any software (new/change/fix) into the test environments.  Approve the final decision relating to the overall quality of the software being tested before this is handed over to business testers.

## **Test Analysis**

- Negotiate directly with project and business teams to gain support/agreement/confirmation on testing effort or resources needed.
- Assist project managers or workstream leads with the estimation of testing effort and the planning of testing tasks as required.
- Create or update detailed test cases and scenarios in advance of test execution activities.
- Work collaboratively with other testing resources to achieve a more integrated and efficient approach to test planning and execution.

#### Test Execution

- Execution of manual and/or automated testing using the prepared test cases and plans.
- Accurately capture the results of testing and raise detailed defect reports/tickets as appropriate. Provide summary results to project managers and workstream leads.
- Participate in "sprint planning games" (this is an Agile term) to gain a full understanding of test requirements. Document and produce test cases where appropriate.
- Participate in post testing/release activities, e.g. post implementation reviews, contributing to lessons learned and future strategy as appropriate.

# Test Techniques

- Implement structured test methodologies (e.g. Agile, V-Model).
- Implement a risk-based testing process. Take on risk assessment of software under test and defects to ensure appropriate coverage is assigned to those areas.

# Test Tools & Technology

- Ensure utilisation of test management tools by test analysts to agreed standards.
- Ensure utilisation of test execution tools by test analysts to agreed standards.
- Ensure utilisation of defect management tools to raise and manage defects by test analysts to agreed standards.
