permitted to cause animals
when used in scientific
research and testing

(approx 10%)

World estimated 10 million animals/year (approx 10%)

125,000 procedures/year (approx 4%)



WHY

MIGHT SEVERE SUFFERING OCCUR?

1. Animals are used to study diseases or conditions which cause severe suffering in humans.

2. A series or combination of less severe events combine to lead to an increase in overall suffering.

**3.** An animal dies unexpectedly, or where the death of an animal is used as an 'endpoint' of a study.
