

RSPCA Pet Insurance UK Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. The prize draw is open to all UK residents aged 18 years or over, except employees of the Promoters (RSPCA and Covéa Insurance) or cottages.com, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
2. Participants will be eligible to enter the prize draw upon purchase and/or renewal of an RSPCA Pet Insurance policy within the “Timeframe” specified in *Condition 4* and have a live policy on the Draw Date specified in Condition 6.

If for any reason a technical interruption, fault or site failure occurs when purchasing online, the Promoter does not take any responsibility for incomplete purchases and any incomplete purchases will not be considered valid for entry into the prize draw. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any purchases which are not completed for any other reason.
